OF KERALA in the Modern Medicine system.	We assume this EOI is the predecessor of a limited RFP process, and that the RFP will only be issued to those companies who are prequalified vide this Expression of Interest (EOI) process.	RFP will be open to anybody who satisfy the pre-qualification criteria. EoI is mainly intended for providing an opportunity for leading firms in the sector to interact with the Project Management Unit and share information on the project. This will provide the firms sufficient input to prepare for RFP submission later.

Page 11, 2.4.1 – Building up of the Citizens Health Database. The base data comprising of the basic demographic details shall be provided by the department based on the SRDH (State Resident Data Hub), SECC (Socio Economic & Caste Census) data. This shall be verified & suitably updated by the field level health worker using hand held devices to make comprehensive root level demographic and public health data related to the entire household, mother and child health, ante natal care, family planning, communicable/ Non Communicable diseases etc.	We are assuming that the State health Information System will be integrated to SRDH for demographic verification, Would strongly recommend an online verification of the Citizen Identity online with CIDR (Central repository of the UIDAI), and use the verified and authenticated data for the State Health information System.	The proposed eHealth system shall be designed to carry out an online verification of the Citizen Identity with Central repository of the UIDAI.
